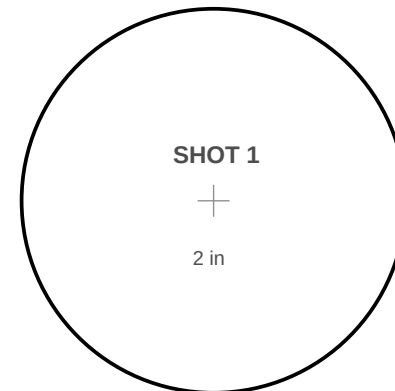
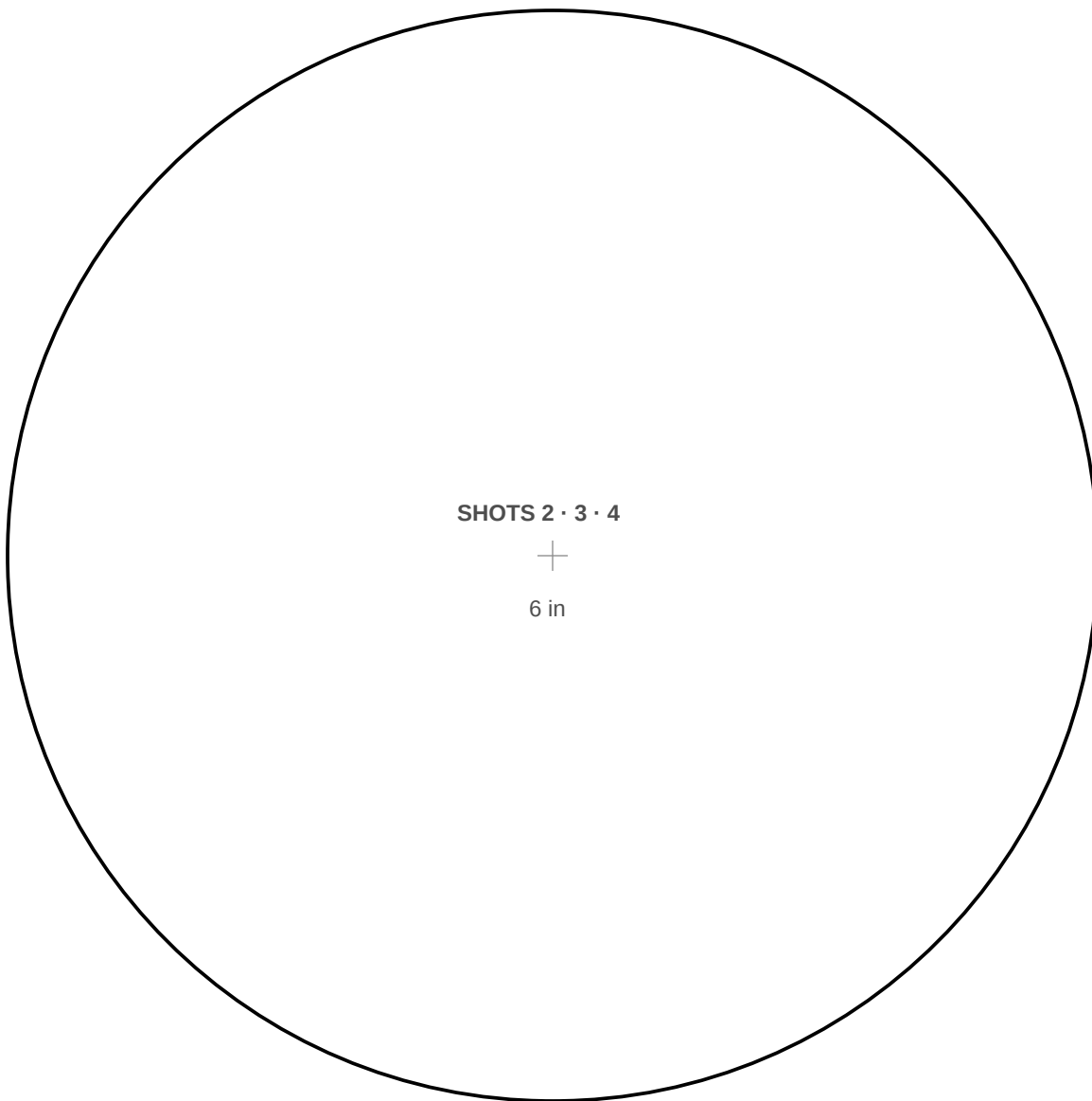
Changing gears — the target size sets your speed.

3 TO 7 YARDS · FROM THE HOLSTER

PRINT AT 100% / ACTUAL SIZE

Turn OFF "Fit to Page" and "Shrink oversized pages".

Check the bar at the foot of the sheet before you hang it.



COURSE OF FIRE

1. 1 round — upper 2 in circle
- 2-4. 3 rounds — 6 in circle
5. 1 round — lower 2 in circle

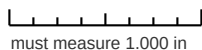
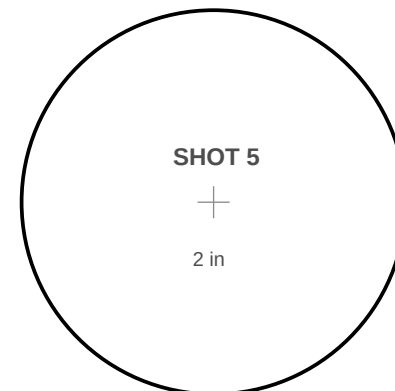
Five rounds, from the holster, in that order.

GOAL: all five hits in 3 to 4 seconds.

When you own it, back up and run it again.

WHAT IT TRAINS

Changing speed to match the target: run the 6 in circle fast, slow down for the 2 in circles. Most shooters hold one tempo for the whole string and drop rounds on the small circles.
