

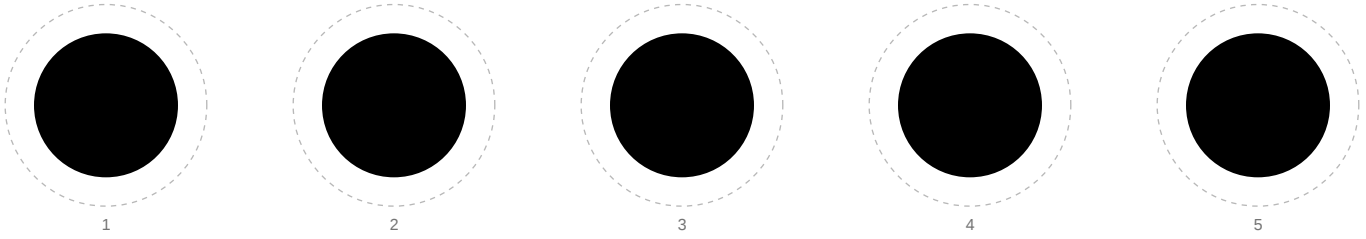
DOT DRILL — 3/4 INCH DOTS

One shot per dot. Each dot is its own shot problem — this is not a group.

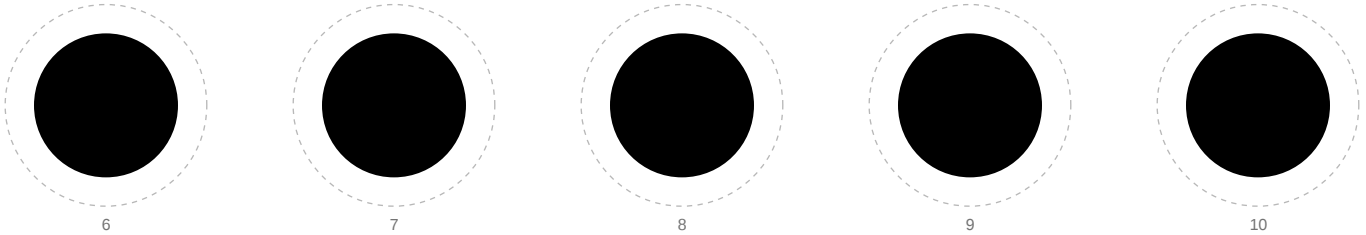
100 YARDS

PRINT AT 100% / ACTUAL SIZE — turn OFF "Fit to Page" and "Shrink oversized pages"

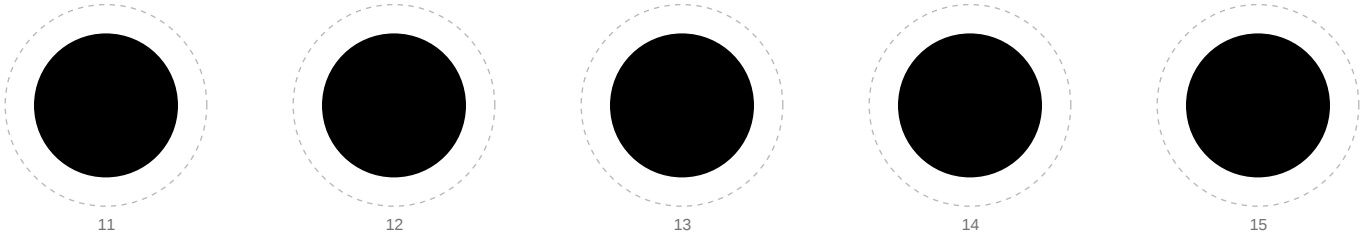
ROW 1 slow fire, prone — 60 sec



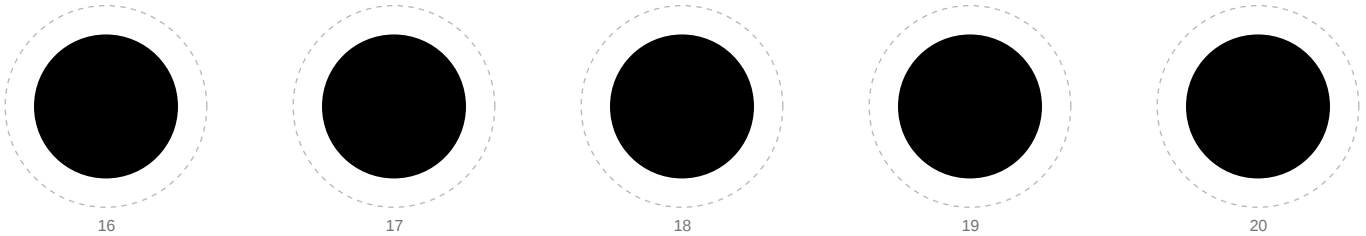
ROW 2 support side, prone — 30 sec



ROW 3 speed, prone — under 30 sec



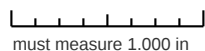
ROW 4 standing to prone, 1 dot each — 30/25/20/15/10 sec



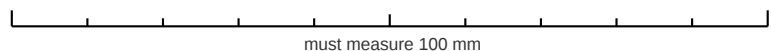
SCORING (low score wins): in the black = 0 · touching the ring = +1 · outside = +2

DOT = 0.75 in = 0.72 MOA = 0.21 mil at 100 yd · RING = 1.15 in = 1.10 MOA = 0.32 mil
