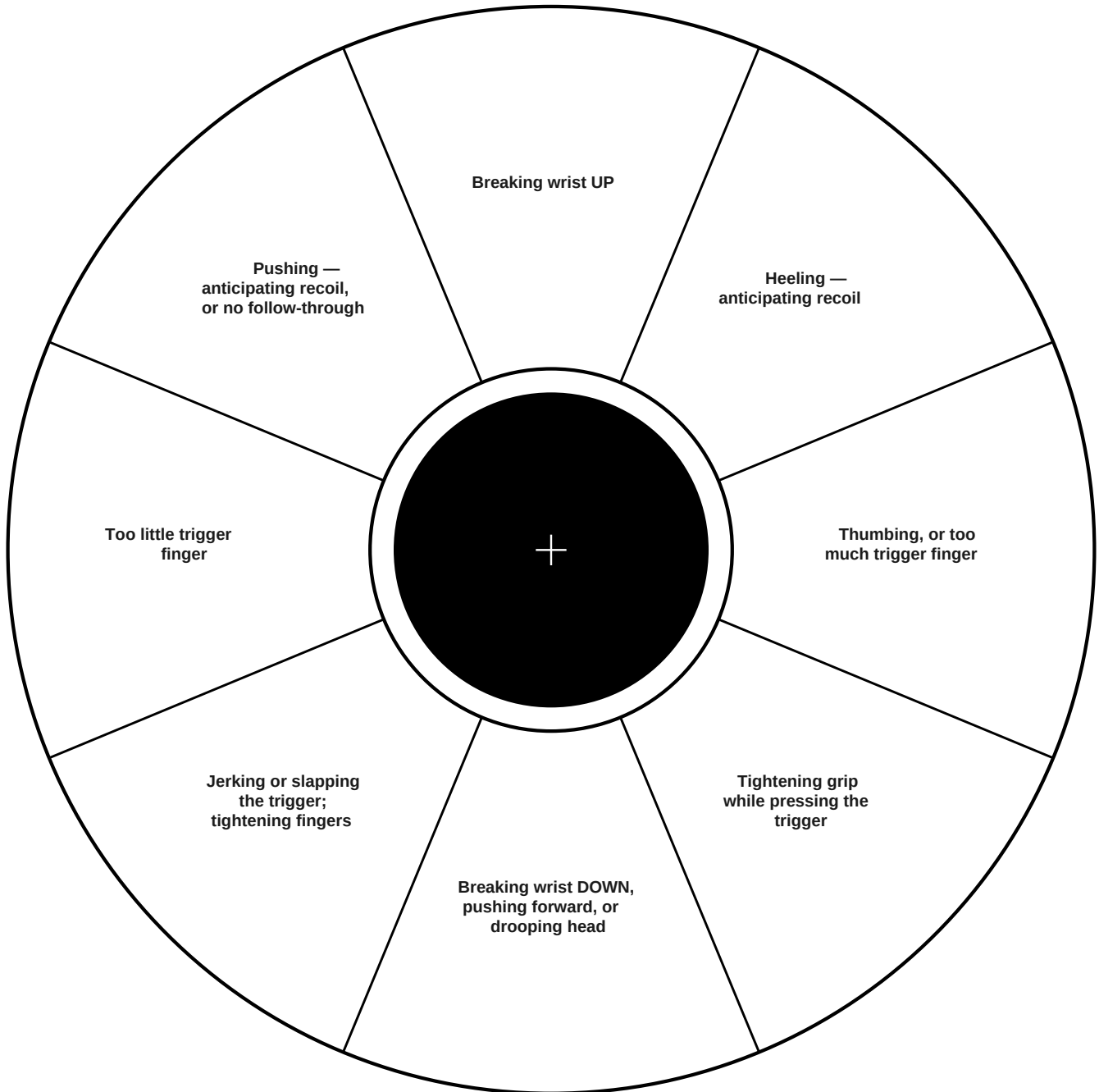


PISTOL DIAGNOSIS TARGET

Aim at the centre. Where the group lands points at the fault that usually put it there.

7 TO 10 YARDS · RIGHT-HANDED SHOOTER

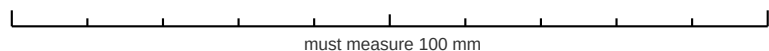
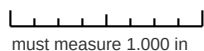
PRINT AT 100% / ACTUAL SIZE — turn OFF "Fit to Page" and "Shrink oversized pages"



LEFT-HANDED? Mirror it — swap left and right, keep high and low as printed.

Treat this as a starting point, not a verdict. Most off-centre groups trace back to trigger control and grip pressure, and a chart cannot see your hands. Confirm anticipation with a ball-and-dummy drill before you rebuild your technique around a diagnosis — if the reticle dips on a dummy round, that is the fault, whatever the wheel says.

Bull = 2.00 in · wheel = 6.90 in outside diameter



Shoot a five-shot group at the centre before reading the wheel — one shot diagnoses nothing.
